


Prediction cells are AUTO-CONTENT cells that can predict the next word or next two words in your sentence. They can be included on any page and in any location.


Here are the steps to add more prediction cells to your page. We are using Fast Talker 2 as an example.

1. Navigate to the page where you want to add Prediction cells. Enter Edit Mode (from the menu bar select **Edit** → **Editing mode** or press F11 on your keyboard.


2. If you need to add extra rows or columns to fit your new cells, you can do so. To add a row select the **Add/delete a row** command from the left side bar.




3. Move the mouse to the gap between the rows where you would like to add the row (a BLUE highlighted row will appear). Press the left mouse button.




4. Select **Stop adding / deleting rows** when you are finished.




5. Resize the cells if required by selecting the white squares at the corner of the cell, hold down the left mouse button and drag the cell bigger or smaller.



6. Select the cells you would like to make prediction cells. To select more than one cell at a time hold the CTRL key on your keyboard or drag around the cells with your mouse whilst holding the left mouse button down.



7. With the mouse, right click on any selected cell → **Choose Auto content** → **Prediction**



8. There should now be 8 prediction cells numbered 1 to 8. Select the **Red Stop button** on the Menu bar button to exit edit mode. Remember to save your changes.
